Prayer ministry is an opportunity to be encouraged by the power, truth and love of God as someone prays with you. This could be prayer for forgiveness, blessing and encouragement. It could be for freedom or healing for mental, physical or spiritual needs. It is not a counselling session. What you share is kept confidential.

When - During Eucharist at our Sunday 10:30 service.

Where: Near the font

How: You are welcome to come to the prayer station as soon as the Prayer Team is in place: during or after the Eucharist .

What: The team will introduce themselves, and ask

"What would you like us to pray for?" Or

"What would you like God to do for you?"

Once you have replied, there will be a short time of quiet as the Team waits on the Spirit. Then they will pray for you. According to Scripture, this may include anointing of oil for those who are sick.

St Barnabas also offers other opportunities for Prayer.

Prayer Chain: There are dedicated Pray-ers who will lift your requests to God over the week. Call the church with your prayer request and the Prayer Team will pray.
