

How then shall we live? (Romans 13)

A new law?

As soon as we say love is a law we realize it's no longer that kind of law.

--love cannot be mechanical, following a command

It's not about doing rather it's about being.

Having the right heart /intention

An example of being renewed in the mind leading to transformation of our true true inner self

--we love *because* God *first* loved us

The example of the Gospel and the passage from Ezekiel show us this development.

We no longer warn others or seek to correct them to save our own soul to save ourselves from blood guilt, instead we warn and correct because we love.

Love is an ideal, presented throughout the New testament as our goal.--Love completes the Law (is the spirit of the law).

But realistically, until we can be motivated by love not doing the right thing but being the right person having the right motivation, until then Paul continues to give us helpful instruction.

The passage ends with one such a very practical piece of advice.

Put on Christ, and do not make provision for gratifying the desires of your old human nature. Or to repeat what Paul said in Romans 12:2 do not be conformed to this world /age but be transformed by the renewing of your mind!

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
