

Welcome back to Church!

It's going to be great to see everyone again. No hugging yet, but someday soon ...

Here are a few protocols that have been put in place to help protect us all:

Before you even leave your home, do a quick self-check:

Do you have a fever, cough, sore throat, runny nose or shortness of breath?

Have you been in close contact with a person who tested positive for CoVid-19?

If you answer "Yes" to any of these, please protect your church family by joining us online instead of in person.

1. When you come in the door - whichever door you use - please use the hand sanitizer provided, put your mask on and proceed to the church, keeping an appropriate distance from the people in front of you.
2. When you arrive at the nave door, nab a Bulletin from the table under the Dorcas window.
3. Proceed to your seat. Places to sit/not sit will be marked.
4. Masks are recommended during the service but are only necessary when you go for communion.
5. There will be no singing during the service.
6. Make up your own "Pass the Peace" gesture - hand-to-heart, two-finger Peace sign, ... There should be no physical contact with anyone outside of your 'cohort'.
7. When you are invited to communion, remember to wear your mask and keep distanced from the person in front of you. Reverend Oz will put the wafer in your hand. You will move to the "X" marked on the floor, remove your mask and consume the host. Replace your mask and use hand sanitizer before returning to your seat.
8. When the service is over, remember to keep an appropriate distance from those around you as you exit through whichever door you entered and make your way to your vehicle.
