

### DID YOU KNOW

IN 1883, THE PROVINCIAL SYNOD AUTHORIZED THE FORMING OF A NEW DIOCESE IN WESTERN CANADA, IN THE DISTRICT OF ASSINIBOIA, N.W.T. THE FORMATION OF THE DIOCESE OF QU'APPELLE, INCLUDED MEDICINE HAT ON ITS WESTERN BOUNDARY, AND BY 1884, THE FIRST ANGLICAN CHURCH SERVICE WAS HELD LOCALLY IN THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH; 40 PEOPLE WERE IN ATTENDANCE. THE FIRST ST. BARNABAS, A WOODEN STRUCTURE, WAS BUILT IN 1886.


